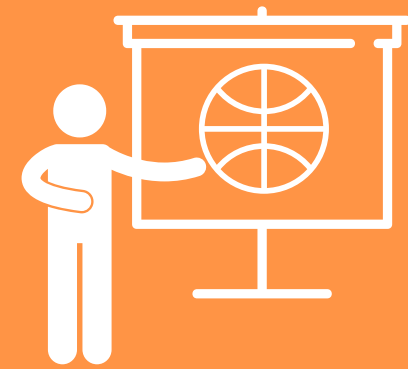

1. REACHING YOUNG PEOPLE - POSSIBLE WAYS OF JOINING THE PROGRAMMES

Via basketball activities / social worker / parent - enters lifecycle at any stage depending on the needs and preferences.

2. INSPIRE THE TARGET - FORMAL EXPOSURE TO OPPORTUNITIES

Introducing young people to things you can do with basketball apart from playing

3. SIGN UP PROCESS / VOLUNTEERING EXPERIENCE WITH MENTORSHIP

Providing young people with an opportunity to SIGN UP for the programme and start their volunteering experience while being mentored.

4. PROVIDE THE QUALIFICATIONS

Providing mentored young people with qualification to become certified coaches, referees, table officials and media crew members.
